

We are committed to protecting your personal privacy and safeguarding your personal data. Below is information on how we collect, process, and share your personal data, as well as your rights in relation to such processing.

Controller and Contact Information

Owl Advokat AB, corporate registration number 559029-9607, is the controller for the processing of personal data described below. This means that we are responsible for ensuring that personal data is processed correctly and in accordance with applicable data protection legislation. If we process your personal data, you have several rights, which are briefly described below. Should you have any questions regarding our processing of your personal data or if you wish to exercise your rights, you may contact us via email, regular mail, or telephone.

What rights do you have?

Right to Lodge a Complaint

If you have objections to or comments on our processing of your personal data, you have the right to contact or lodge a complaint with the Swedish Authority for Privacy Protection (Integritetsskyddsmyndigheten), which supervises our personal data processing, or with the competent authority in jurisdictions outside the EU where our foreign offices operate.

Right to Information and Access

You may request confirmation as to whether we are processing your personal data and receive a copy thereof (a so-called data subject access request), along with further information on how we process your personal data.

Right to Rectification

If you consider your personal data to be incorrect or incomplete, you may request that it be corrected or supplemented.

Right to Object

You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data where such processing is based on a legitimate interest. If we are unable to demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for continuing the processing, we must cease such processing. You always have the right to object to the use of your personal data for direct marketing purposes.

Right to Restriction of Processing

In certain circumstances, you may request the restriction of processing of your personal data. This means that the data will be marked so that it may only be processed for specific limited purposes. For example, restriction may be possible if you have objected to the processing, believe that the data is inaccurate, or if the processing is unlawful. By requesting restriction, you may, at least temporarily, prevent us from using the personal data for purposes other than, for example, defending legal claims.

Right to Erasure

You may, in certain circumstances, have your personal data erased. Erasure may be relevant for data that is no longer necessary for the purpose for which it was collected or for data processed based on your consent, should you withdraw that consent. In some situations, we may be unable to delete your personal data, such as where we are legally required to retain it, if it remains necessary for the purpose for which it was collected, or if our interest in continuing the processing outweighs your interest in its deletion.

Right to Data Portability

If we process your personal data on the basis of a contract or your consent, you may, in some cases, request that your data be transferred for use elsewhere — e.g., by obtaining a copy in a machine-readable format and transferring it to another data controller.

Right to Withdraw Consent

Where we process your personal data based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. Upon withdrawal, we will cease processing any personal data based on such consent.

Please note that the above rights may be restricted in light of the duty of confidentiality and recordkeeping obligations applicable under the Swedish Bar Association's regulations or other applicable laws and regulations. In some cases, the restriction or deletion of your personal data may prevent us from fulfilling our obligations.

Special Information Regarding the Processing of Personal Data in Connection with Our Engagements

We collect your personal data from you or your employer in connection with the preparation, administration, or execution of an engagement. We may also receive and collect personal data from other individuals involved in and connected to the engagement. In some cases, we may supplement such data with information obtained from other sources, such as publicly available or private search engines and registers.

You are under no obligation to provide us with your personal data. However, failure to do so may prevent us from accepting the engagement or fulfilling our obligations to you or the legal entity you represent.
